

**Town of Greenwood
Monthly Board Meeting
Minutes
February 9, 2026**

The monthly board meeting for the Town of Greenwood was called to order by Chairman Mitch Peters at 7:00 pm. Board members present were Mitch Peters, Michael Wudi, Travis Fuchs, clerk Jill Scheithauer, and treasurer Linda Bartelt. Graderman Kurt Bube also present. Also present were town residents Abe Miller and Ivan Schrock.

Minutes- The minutes for the January 14, 2026 meeting were read by Jill. A motion was made by Mike and seconded by Travis to approve the minutes from the January meeting. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report/Pay Bills – Linda updated the board with the amount of property taxes taken in and provided a list of delinquent payors. The firetruck loan has been paid in full! A motion was made by Travis and seconded by Mitch to approve the treasurer's report and pay the monthly bills. Motion passed.

Public Input – Ivan Schrock introduced himself to the board and showed appreciation for how welcome he feels to the town.

Road Updates – Kurt hasn't received the blades/teeth from Winter Equipment. Mitch talked to the Highway Department about placing horse & buggy signs in our township now that we have Amish residents moving into Greenwood. According to the highway commissioner, there are no such signs located anywhere in Taylor County. At this point, no signs will go up unless there become issues within the township with traffic. A main concern is on Highway C between Trout Avenue and Wood Creek Avenue given the hills in that area. There is potential cost-share program for the 6'-20' culverts/bridges which we can apply for to replace potential bridges in which we would receive a 90% reimbursement. Mitch will bring the paperwork to next meeting.
